	 Proximity to neighbouring houses. 			
	 Reliance on staff (including casuals) to implement firecontrol measures and evacuation procedures. 			
	 Staff (particularly casuals) not being aware or unclear on evacuation procedures and warden responsibilities. 			
	 Trees on the Service premises dropping leaves and branches, blocking gutters and cluttering grounds. 			
	 Service not equipped with fire alarms or detectors in all areas. 			
	 Storage of flammable goods and materials on site.
