Detail of the risk event/scenario: Snake bites

RISK DRIVERS	Key drivers:			
	High incidences of snake sightings in Armidale and preschool surrounds			
	Presence of venomous snakes in NSW			
	Excursions to external premises where snakes could be a risk			
RISK RATING	MEDIUM			
CONTROLS	Current controls in place:			
	 Ensure that lawns and garden are maintained to allow for good visibility and discourage snakes. 			
	 Ensure no compost heaps and rubbish piles build up. 			
	 Ensure First aid trained staff on duty at all times 			
	 Ensure fully stocked first aid boxes on premises 			
	 Installation of snake repellers at the property boundary to discourage snake entry to the premises. 			
	 Routine daily checks of the perimeter and building. 			
	 Reptile safety talks/workshops delivered to children at the Service. 			
	 Snake safety documentation available to staff and families 			
	 Display of emergency contact numbers. 			
	 Assessment for snakes undertaken within all excursion risk assessments.

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KEY	RESPONSE	=
MEA	SURES:	

- Do not approach the snake
- Contact a snake catcher
- Clear all children and staff from the vicinity of the snake
- Administer First aid
- Contact emergency services (000)
- Contact Nominated Supervisor and Director if required
- Notify the Committee and parents as to the safety of children in care.
- Notify the regulatory authority within 24 hrs (if required)

RECOVERY MEASURES:

- Assess the need for, and arrange, counselling support if required.
- Replenish first aid kit (if required)
- Review the risk action plan for snake bites
